Institute of Law to host 40 speakers from across the globe; speakers stress on need for moral uprightness

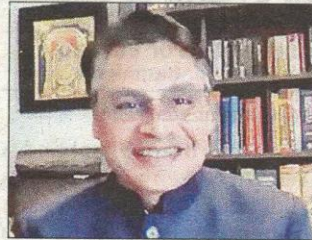
