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Academic Continuity through Online Teaching

The Institute of Law has adopted the online mode of teaching-learning process in these challenging times of Covid-19. All courses being offered by the Institute in this academic year have been delivered online. This involves a range of subjects that are oriented towards law, commerce, humanities and some professional courses. For teaching, a blend of techniques such as podcasts, video lectures, audio enabled PowerPoint presentations, and virtual meetings with students on secured platforms were used. Important learning resources were shared with students from both national as well as international resources. Several e-mediums have been used such as Google Classrooms; Google Meet; Zoom, Webinar, WebEx, emails and WhatsApp groups to ensure that questions of students are cleared in each subject are addressed and answered as and when they arise. This has led to an effective teaching-learning process. Viva for dissertation courses has also been carried online so that valuable feedback can be given to the students. The Institute is also conducting assessments for all its courses through a properly designed examination. Enough time has been given to the students to complete the exam. The Institute is also flexible in terms of submission deadlines and modes of submission, either through pen and paper model or online, thus catering to the diverse needs and comfort of the students.

Online Mediation Summit

The Institute conducted an Online Mediation Exercise, keeping in mind to provide an edge to the students for conducting dispute resolution process in online mode, which is also the need of the hour. There were 33 groups and the exercise was conducted over a period of one week starting from April 8 to 15, 2020. The students were divided into groups of five members each, wherein one was to play the role of mediator, two counsels on behalf of disputing parties and two parties to the dispute respectively. Six different problems were formulated, which covered a wide range of disputes where mediation plays an important role in settlement of the same such as neighbouring, service and family matters. The students were trained in putting the classroom learning of mediation into practice systematically.

Instagram Live Sessions






