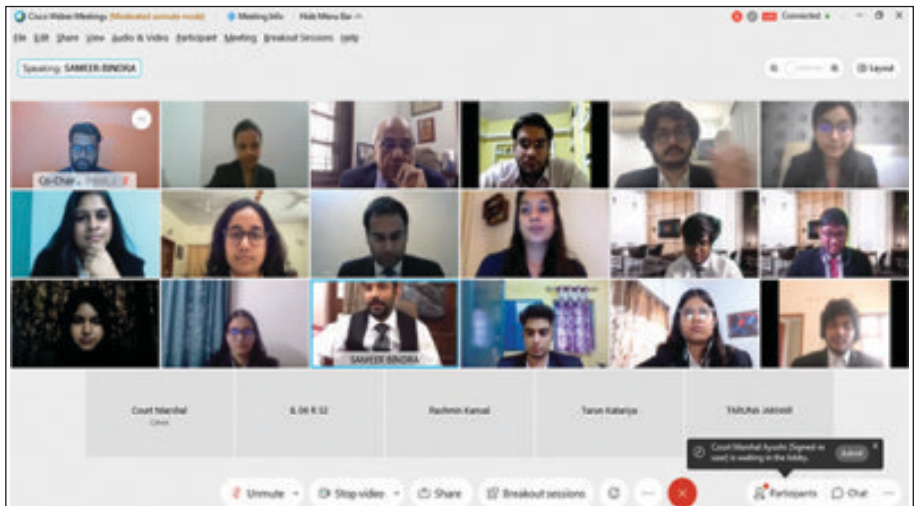

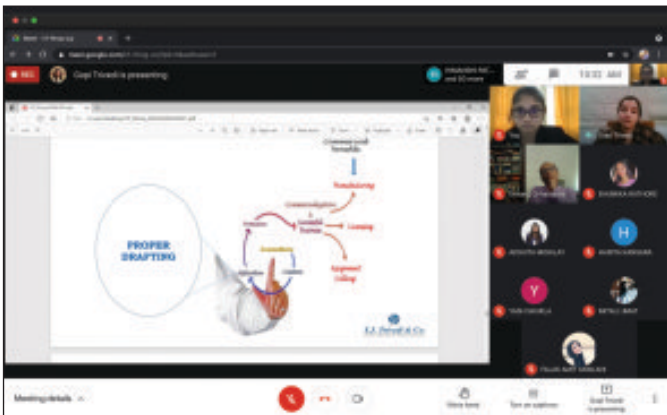

Marital disputes rising in family court, but... Filing, disposal of cases hit hard

Research by Nirma law student finds functioning of Family Court almost comes to standstill during the pandemic; if not addressed now, courts will be flooded with cases, the study warns

Marital disputes have been on the rise owing to pressures and anxieties stemming from lockdowns and restrictions experienced during the Corona pandemic, but filing and disposal of the cases in Family Courts has not kept pace with the increase in number of disputes, suggests a study conducted by a law student of the Nirma University.



Research finds that no cases were filed in April, May and June 2020

The pandemic has led to a huge pileup of cases, especially related to maintenance, alimony, Section 48B of CrPc, and Section 18 of Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act

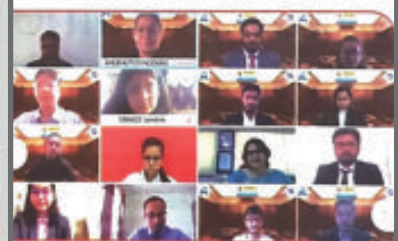
INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION COMPETITION: INSTITUTE OF LAW, NIRMA UNIVERSITY
