

## **Twenty - Second Convocation**



The Twenty Second Convocation of the University was held on October 21, 2016. Lord Bhikhu Parekh, the political theorist and labour member of the House of Lords was the Chief Guest for the occasion.

Lord Bhikhu delivered the convocation address and also presented scholastic medals to the students of the University. In his motivational address he reflected on the quality of our higher education; He concentrated upon the quality of scientific teaching in our Universities. He stressed on how Higher

education is not about rote learning or accumulation of knowledge. Rather it is about the cultivation of the capacity to think analytically and critically. He also emphasized that if India is to create world class universities and provide high quality education to it's students, it desperately needs to attract world class scholars and scientists, principally from abroad.

During the convocation, the students from the Institute of Technology, Institute of Management, Institute of Pharmacy, Institute of Science and Institute of Law were conferred degrees by Dr Karsanbhai K. Patel, the President of the University. In all 1797 students were awarded degrees and 41 students were awarded medals during the convocation. Dr Patel delivered the Presidential address on the occasion. Dr Anup Singh, Director General, Nirma University presented the concluding address at the convocation.

His was the winning entry from 5,295 entries by 2,458 participants from 53 countries: and evaluated by 58 member-strong jury comprised of international experts The awards are a true acknowledgement of the design excellence, innovation and originality of Indian Design. The iF Design Award Winner Logo is an internationally established symbol identifying outstanding achievements in design

Here's an excerpt from the conversation we had with him about his success story.

When did you realise your passion for mechanical engineering? I have
always had a keen interest in math and science and an urge to do something
innovative that can improve the lives of people from all walks of life. Whilst I
was doing my bachelors I was greatly inspired by the faculties at the Institute
of Technology with whom I interacted. I particularly remember my final year
project, which was an "Octagonal shaped solar concentrator" which was the
first project to be manufactured in the workshop of the Mechanical
Engineering Department in 1999-2000.

### Was Nirma University instrumental in you achieving any of your career goals?

The attitude I developed as a student at Institute of Technology helped me in my first job as a lecturer at VVP Engineering College. Am also thankful to the faculties who taught me basic applications, which was the foundation of the many award winning products designed and developed by me.

- Any tips you would like to give to the current batch of Students on what should they focus on to achieve such success? Always have an attitude of learning by practically doing the same. I believe there is a difference of 5 hours between the state of "I don't know" and "I know". Always be ready to give those crucial 5 hours for learning. I believe that, "It is never important what you know, but what you can learn and apply to improve one's life".
- A mantra that you follow in your daily routine/ life that helped to be successful? Always dream big and try to implement futuristic ideas in today's world by creative thinking and innovative approach. Continuously learning new things and try to apply design thinking approach. Everyone always want to improve their life and it is duty of Design Engineer to make that happen fast and sustainable
- What process / hardships you faced to attain the success you have achieved till date.

It is common thinking that designing and development are costly and time consuming affairs and International R&D cannot be done at local levels. We are working very hard to change this mentality. We are applying product design with brand design strategy and trying to convert OEM to Brand Product Manufacturer. But we need to work hard to make people understand the power of design and innovation to create branding.

When we started Universal Designovation Lab LLP in 2012-2013 there was no start-up atmosphere in India. UDLAB was started without any investment from outside, we had received an advance of Rs.2,30,000/- for our first project even

before having a bank account in the name of our company. We faced many difficulties to get finance from banks as there are no banking finance policies for software purchase. We faced difficulty in opening a bank account in nationalised banks as UDLAB is LLP and many banks were reluctant to open an account for LLP in 2012-2013.
