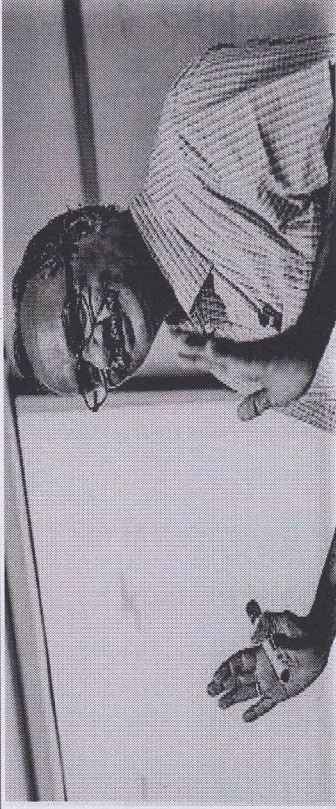

Prof. A. Raghuram Raju teaches Philosophy at the Dept. of Philosophy, University of Hyderabad. Author of multiple books on Indian Philosophy, his most notable contributions in the field are "Debates in Indian Philosophy: Classical, Colonial, and Contemporary" (OUP, 2006) Modernity in Indian Social Theory (OUP, 2010) "Philosophy and India: Ancestors, Outsiders, and predecessors" (OUP, 2013) "Modern frames and premodern themes in Indian Philosophy" (Routledge, 2017) He has lectured extensively on the subject across India and has been a Visiting Faculty at Delhi University and Smith College, Southampton USA. Prof. Raju was also a fellow at the IAAS, Shimla in 1993. Currently he is engaged in developing content for UGC's e-PG pathshala program as the principal investigator.
