Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Does PharmD program approved by PCI?

Yes, Pharm.D. program is approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).

What is the mode of Application?

- Applications must be submitted through online portal available on Institute of Pharmacy, Nirma University website.
- Apply Online: https://admissions-ip.nirmauni.ac.in/
- Downloadable Application form (offline mode) is not available.
- Application Processing Fees (Rs. 1200/-) to be paid Online by Net Banking/ Debit /Credit card.

Which are the documents required for online application? – Soft Copy of Following Documents

- Candidate's Photograph (JPG image)
- Marksheet: HSC examination (12th Std-10+2 pattern)
- Admission form Fees payment copy
- Any other certificates to be submitted as the Admission Committee deems necessary
- First attempt certificate is required

What is the schedule for admission process?

Date for Initiation of Online Application	15 th May, 2025
Last Date for online Application	30 th June 2025
Merit list display	7 th July 2025
Date for counselling for Admission	11 th July 2025

What is Eligibility for Admission?

A pass in any of the following examinations -

- (1) 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the subjects, Mathematics or Biology or Both
- (2) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

Provided that a student should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

What is admission process?

- After preparation of merit list, IPNU will announce the admission process to be held at IPNU based upon merit list and Candidates will be informed by email and/or website notification.
- Allotment of seats shall be made on the basis of merit and availability of seats.
- Students are required to report at the IPNU for conformation of admission and payment of the fees
 Rs. 2.95 lakh / 5,000* USD or its equivalent INR for the first year on the day of admission through
 Demand draft/Cheque prepared on the name of Institute of Pharmacy Under Nirma University.

Is there hostel facility available on campus?

What about Placement to PharmD pass-out?

- Corporate Relation Manager helps each student in exploring placement opportunities by inviting various companies/hospitals for campus recruitment for interested students.

What about the admission to international students' admission?

15% of the total seats are allocated for international students under the Supernumerary categories, including Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries and South East Asia (CIWGC-SEA), Overseas Citizen of India (OCI), and Foreign Nationals (FN). Among these, 5% of seats are reserved for CIWGC-SEA and 10% for OCI/FN. If the OCI/FN seats are not filled, they become available to CIWGC-SEA applicants.
