

General Guidelines for Admission at the Institute of Law, Nirma University for the Academic Year 2022-2023:

Undergraduate Programmes

Up to 15% of the total intake is likely to be filled-in under NRI/NRI Sponsored category.

Over and above the approved intake, 15% supernumerary seats will be for Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/ Foreign Nationals (FN) and Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries-South East Asia (CIWGC-SEA). The application procedure and detailed information regarding eligibility for admission under FN/PIO/CIWGC-SEA category will be separately notified by the University.

B. Eligibility

A candidate should have passed Higher Secondary/Intermediate Examinations (10+2) or its equivalent examinations with not less than 45% aggregate marks. Candidates who are appearing in the qualifying examination in May 2022 are also eligible for applying to the Institute. However, they shall be required to produce an evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission.

C. Admission Procedure

- Admission is based on the inter se All India merit rank of CLAT 2022.
- The eligibility for the age criteria will be same as prescribed by the CLAT 2022 Authority.
- Candidates must fill CLAT 2022 application form before filling in ILNU Application Form.

D. Application Procedure

• Mode of Application:

There is only one mode of application, i.e., ONLINE. The online application can be accessed by a candidate by registering oneself by creating a LOGIN ACCOUNT.

Mode of payment (Form Processing fee):

- General Category INR 2500/- + Applicable Taxes (GST @ 18%) = INR 2950.
- NRI / NRI Sponsored Category INR 3500/- + Applicable Taxes (GST @ 18%) = INR 4130. (Candidates applying to NRI / NRI Sponsored category would also be considered under general category subject to fulfilment of basic eligibility criteria).
- The payment shall be remitted by Credit Card/Debit Card or Net Banking.

Last Date for Receiving Application Form

The application procedure and detailed information regarding eligibility for admission under FN/PIO/CIWGC-SEA category will be separately notified by the University.

A. Eligibility

A candidate should have successfully passed, three years LL. B. Programme after graduation or five years Integrated Law Degree Programme as recognized by the Bar Council of India with minimum 55% marks in aggregate.

Those who have appeared in aforementioned exam and the result is awaited can apply for this programme. However, admission will be subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria at the time of admission.

B. Admission Procedure

Admission Process for LL. M. (One Year) is based on PG CLAT rank. In case of NRI / NRI Sponsored seat, if PG CLAT candidates are not available, the Institute can conduct its own examination.
