## A Focussed Group Discussion on 'Gaming Laws in India' at ILN4U

The Institute of Law, Nirma University in association with Neetigya Legal Consultants LLP organized a Focused Group Discussion on the theme 'Gaming Law in India' on 5th March 2022. The chief guest at the event was Hon'ble Mr Justice A K Sikri (Former Judge, Supreme Court of India) with other dignitaries including Advocate Mr Maulik Nanavati (Neetigya Legal Consultants), Dr. Anup K Singh (Director General, Nirma University) and Dr Madhuri Parikh (Dean and Director i/c, ILNU). The esteemed speakers at the event were Mr Gopal Jain (Senior Advocate, Supreme Court of India), Mr Shambu Singh (Retd. IAS), Mr Nandan Kamath (Principal Lawyer, Law NK Bangalore), Ms Ranjana Adhikari (Partner, Indus Law Mumbai), Mr Anwar Shirpurwala (CEO, Federation of Indian Fantasy Sports), Mr Sunil Krishnamurthy (General Secretary, All India Gaming Federation), Mr Amrit Mathur (Advisor, Federation of Indian Fantasy Sports) and Mr Rahat Khanna (Head, Public Policy initiatives for Games 24x7).

The chief guest Hon'ble Mr Justice A K Sikri emphasized the fact that there is a lack of uniformity in the legal position across states on Gaming Laws. The legal regime is ambiguous that poses a challenge for investors with a significant compliance burden for game operators. Stressing on the two aspects of Online Gaming as the debate between the skill and the chance, he elaborated that this particular sector can create many job opportunities with a need to monitor the regulatory compliance in order to safeguard the gamers against illegal activity. In a highly interactive session, the focused group discussion brought forth issues relevant to the current advancements in the domain, which engaged and motivated the students to pursue further research in Gaming Laws.

The discussion was mainly towards identifying the legal issues involved in dealing with energy trilemma, exploring legal solutions for the same, and chart out a roadmap of legal steps in resolving the energy trilemma through legal means which is a major task before the international community in general and the developing countries

Water scarcity in India is an ongoing water crisis that affects nearly 600 million people each year. 

- NSS UNIT, ILNU conducted the Winter Blanket Drive, in order to collect and donate warm clothes to the needy from 11th – 15th January 2022.



- NSS Unit, ILNU selected Soumya Khanna (20bal059) as




the Volunteer for the Month of January, who consistently worked as a volunteer in all the events organized by NSS including the virtual open-mic "GOONJ".

## DANCE COMMITTEE


