The Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on “NEP: A Renewed Focus on Development of MOOC Courses through ‘Do It Yourself (DIY) & Workshop Mode’” is a two-week initiative by the Institute of Law, Nirma University, scheduled from 29 June to 15 July 2026.

This programme responds to the evolving demands of higher education under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, emphasizing innovation in pedagogy, digital content creation, and learner-centric teaching. - Design assessments and rubrics aligned with Outcome-Based Learning (OBL).
- Build institutional capacity for digital pedagogy and content dissemination.

The FDP is open to faculty members, research scholars, and professionals from Law, Humanities, Commerce, and allied disciplines, aiming to foster a community of educators equipped for the digital transformation of higher education.

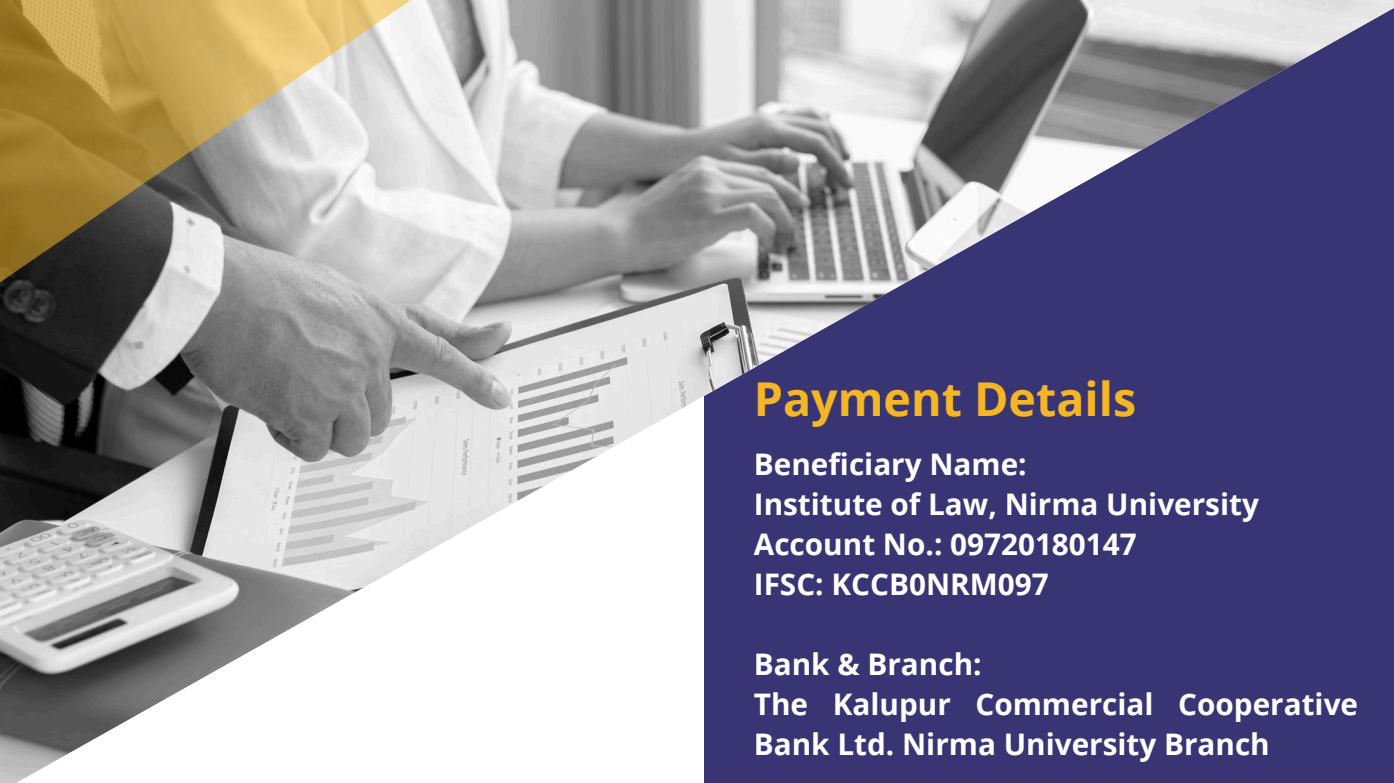
