

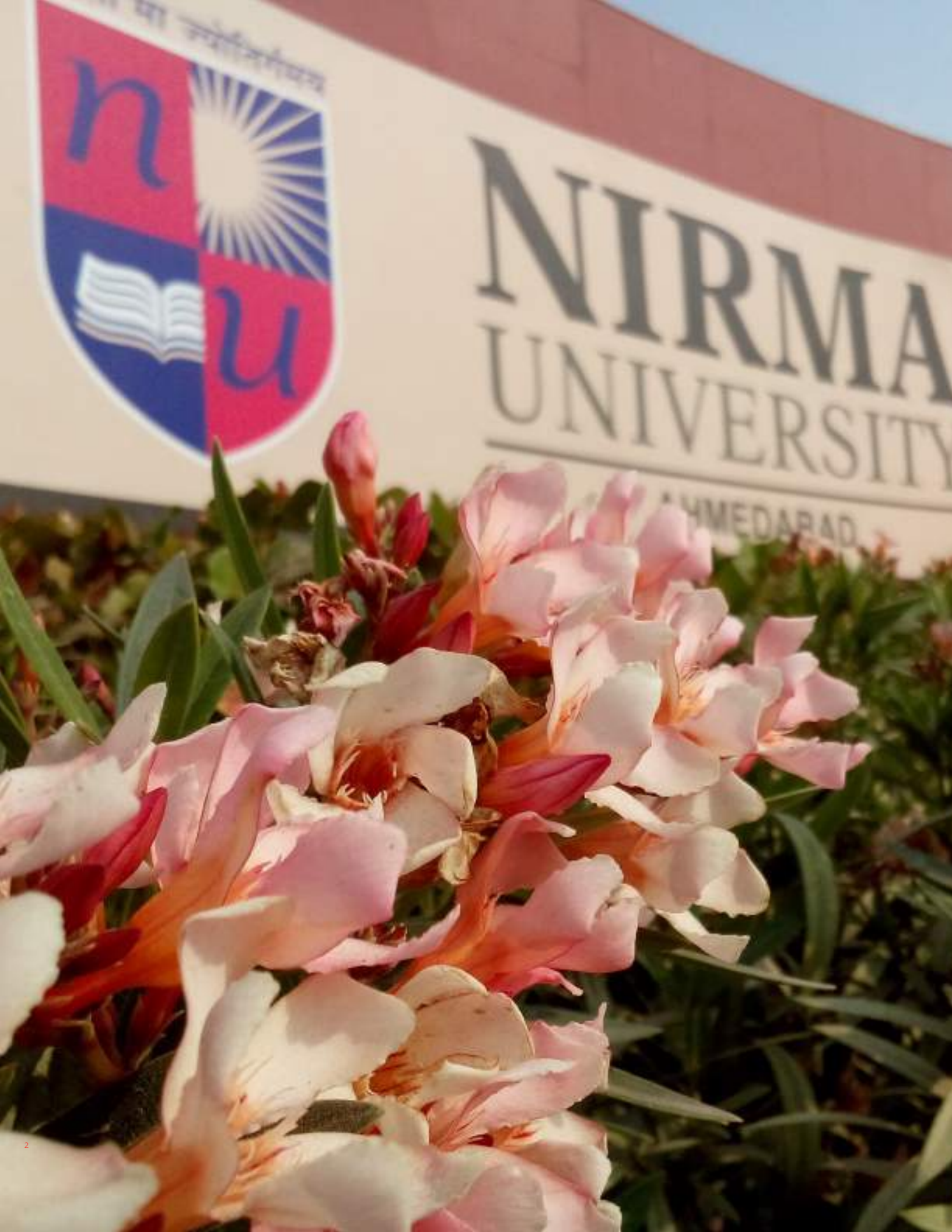

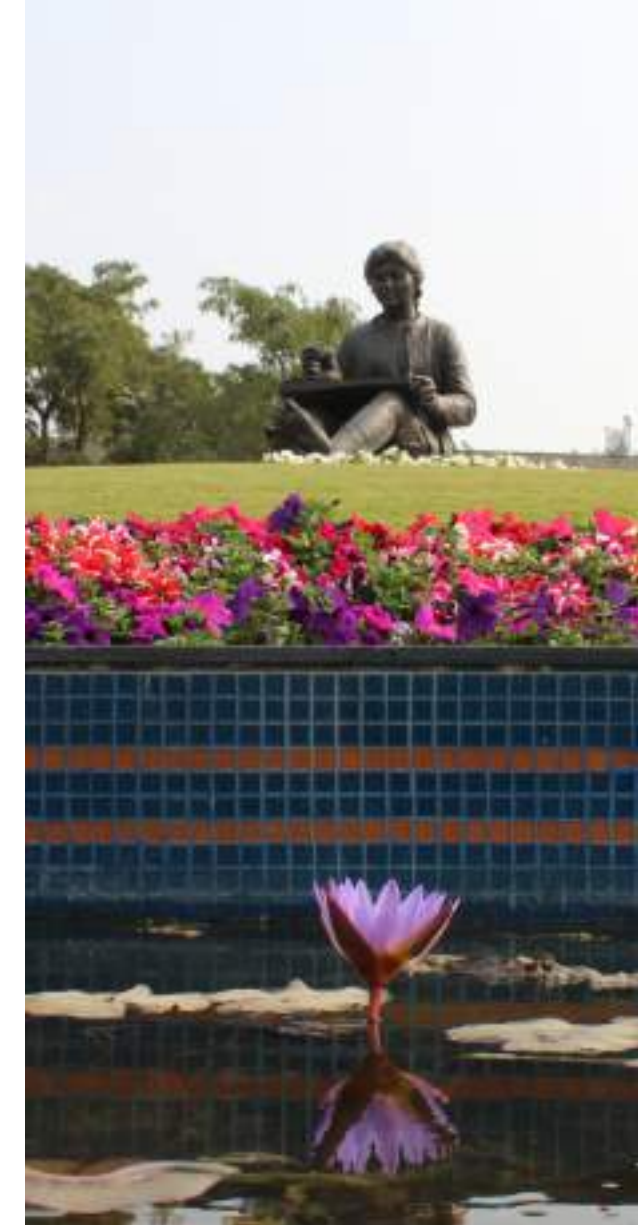

Indian cities are undergoing a very rapid urban development and transformation with profound socio-cultural, economic and environmental implications. Migration from rural to urban areas has reached unprecedented levels and the resultant development and transformation of urban areas poses greater challenges to create socially and economically inclusive public realm in the cities. Also, in the recent times of environmental and health crisis, cities now will have to be re-imagined in creating liveable as well as environmentally sustainable future. Urban Design is the physical organization of cities and

towns in terms of architecture, infrastructure, and so on. It also involves the creation and implementation of various processes intended to allow for successful future development

Nirma University is one of India's leading universities based in Ahmedabad (Gujarat). Spread across the sprawling lush green 115-acres campus, the University has a host of institutes, departments and centers, including Institute of Technology, Institute of Management, Institute of Pharmacy, Institute of Science, Institute of Law, Institute of Architecture & Planning,

Institute of Commerce, Department of Design, Faculty of Doctoral Studies and Research, Centre for Continuing Education, Centre for Entrepreneurship, Centre for Advanced Instrumentation and Centre for Robotics and Automation. ### Key characteristics

The B.Arch program at Institute of Architecture and Planning, Nirma University completed 7 years at the end of academic year 2020-21. The M. Arch program in Urban Design will offer post-graduate opportunity to our existing students. The M. Arch program in Urban Design is duly approved by Council of Architecture.

The multi-disciplinary nature of the course has a huge potential to take advantage of other programs and courses at the Nirma University. It will also bring cohesion and collaboration among the institutes. Labs and research at the institutes will also facilitate collaboration with peers.



### Program Objective

The program objectives are as follows :

1. To prepare the students to develop a holistic view of the city as a basis for re-thinking and re-imagining the city/city components;
2. To contribute to a clearer understanding of cities, particularly of Indian cities, through research, documentation and urban design interventions in 3rd dimension;
3. To contribute to the urban design knowledge base through primary/ secondary research, theoretical pursuits and publications; and
4. To address the various urban design issues that are faced by cities through studio exercises, sponsored research and publications in collaboration with other organizations and stakeholders.


### M.Arch - Career Prospects:

Arch in Urban Design program would be advanced urban design practitioners prepared for careers in a variety of professional settings in urbanism; urban and regional planning; public and urban policy; strategic design; development of social, cultural, and environmental enterprises; and urban research and analysis.

Post-graduates with M. Arch in Urban Design program will :

- work and collaborate with Architecture and Urban Design firms, developer and construction firms, central government agencies, state government agencies, urban local bodies, municipal corporations, private sector infrastructural development, private practice and not-for-profit organizations, and/ or
- pursue doctoral level study or other research interests as the program is designed also to provide a research foundation.

## RESEARCH AND CONSULTANCY

Despite its young age, the institute has started taking significant steps in research and consultancy with interesting combination of projects. Director Prof. Utpal Sharma has been involved with several state, national and international level consultancy projects related to public policy and urban planning such as Myanmar Housing Policy, Shimla Master Plan, GIFT City expansion to name a few. IAPNU has collaborated with the Gujarat Institute of Development Research (GIDR) – an ICSSR institution for preparing detailed reports of the planning projects in the coastal areas of south India for NCSCM, Chennai and the MoEFCC, Government of India.

IAPNU is also engaged in the documentation process of India's first UNESCO World Heritage City 'Ahmedabad'. Documentation of traditional house forms in Pols of walled city, is undertaken by IAPNU for Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation. The documentation focuses on climate responsive and social adaptability of indigenous house-form of famous Pols and understand the patterns that reflect Gujarati community's organisational structure and societal cohesion. The project is also studying and comprehending the shaded narrow streets and 'chowks' in the inner parts of the 'pols' creating an urban micro-climate suitable for outdoor activities in a semi-arid region and 'otla' or seating place on the plinth, at the entrance of every house identified as unique socio cultural phenomenon promoting interaction with the street and houses across the street.

RESIDE is Residential building energy demand reduction in India. It is a major research collaboration project between India and the UK, funded by the Indian Department of Science and Technology (DST) and the UK's Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC). IAPNU conducting the research to identify Ahmedabad's residential building energy demand by undertaking analysis of 400 households.

The institute has also established IGLUS Centre of Excellence ICE (Innovative Governance of Large Urban Systems Centre of Excellence), an initiative by GIFT City in association with École Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne (EPFL), Switzerland and Institute of Architecture and Planning, Nirma University to facilitate sharing of knowledge and global best practices about urban initiatives around the world.

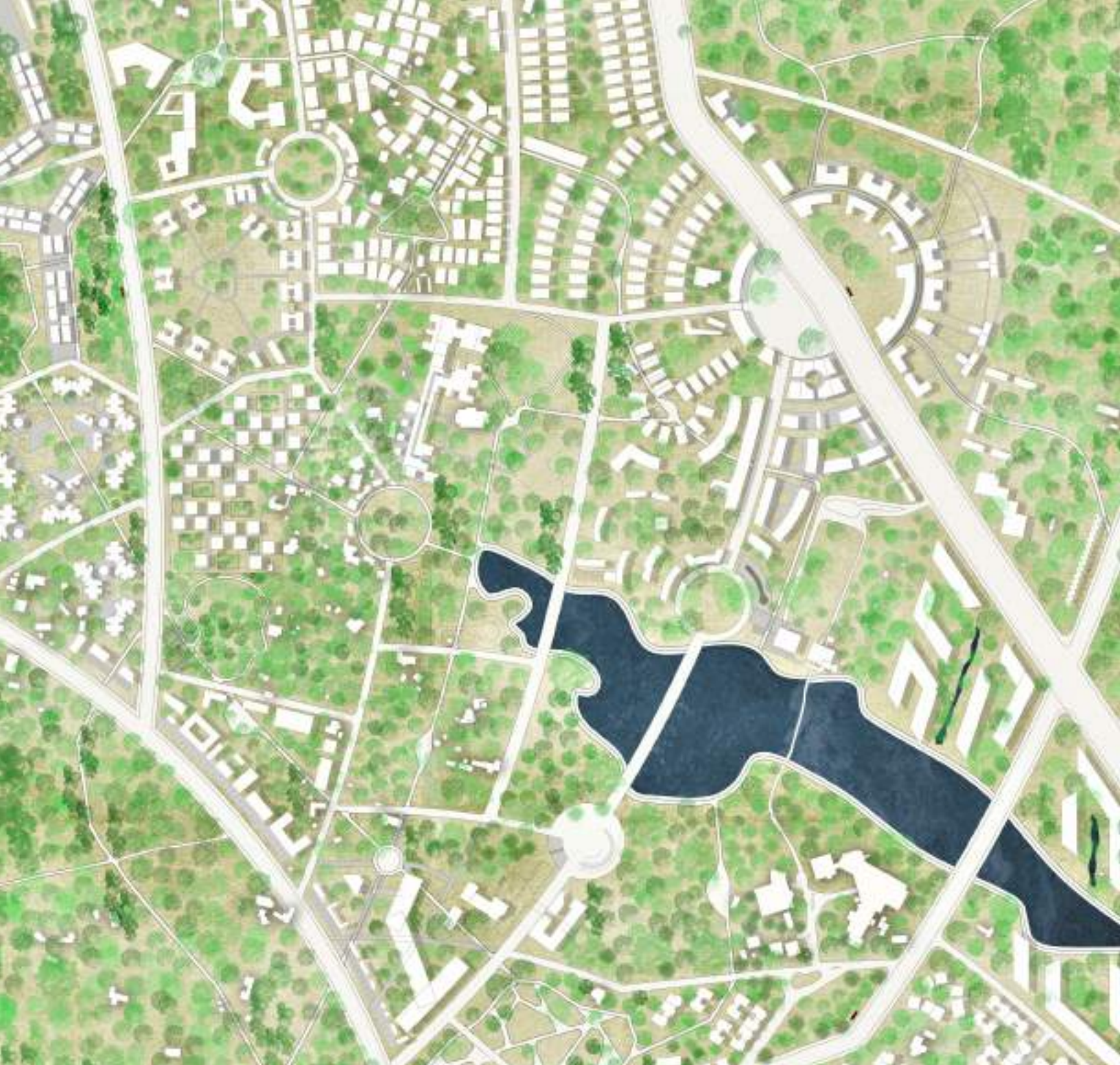
