IAPNU M.Plan Entrance Test: 14th June 2025

Institute of Architecture and Planning, Nirma University has scheduled an entrance test on 14th June, 2025 at Ahmedabad, Guwahati, Jaipur, Indore, Vijaywada and Pune¹. The eligibility criteria and syllabus are as follows:

Eligibility Criteria for PG Entrance Test

- i. Bachelor's degree in Planning, or Civil Engineering, or Architecture (from any University / Institutions in India or Abroad or its equivalent recognized by the Government of India); OR
- ii. Master's degree in Economics, or Sociology, or Geography (from any University / Institution in India or Abroad recognized by the Government of India).
- iii. Other qualifications or experience which the ITPI Council may accept from time to time as equivalent to the above after considering the background, training and experience of a candidate individually.

No candidate with less than 55% marks in aggregate at the qualifying examination shall be admitted to the planning course.

- 5. **Essay Writing (Short Answer)** A 100-150 word response on a given topic related to planning or general issues (1 question)
