Report of Singapore Visit, September 2017

It was decided by the Vice President Shri K. K. Patel to delegate Dr Mehul R Naik, IT-NU to Singapore with following objectives:

- (i) To represent Nirma University at Singapore Gujarati Samaj (SGS) event;
- (ii) To initiate collaborative talks with NUS and NTU Universities.
- (iii) To conduct an alumni meet.

(1) At Singapore Gujarati Samaj (SGS) Event: (Sept 22 – 24, 7 PM to 1 AM)

- SGS hosts Navratri celebration every year. This year it was in Max Atria, Singapore Expo from Sept 22 to 24, 2017. About 2000 people participated in Raas-Garba every day.
- As one of the sponsors, announcement through PA system was made every day about NU's SEA and PIO admission quota, and emails about NU programs were sent to SGS members.
- Interested people visited NU's stall and interacted with Dr Mehul R Naik. The noted points are:
 - ➤ People know NU very well, but did not know about SEA and PIO quota. So, a buzz is created now among the Singaporean Indians.
 - > Parents inquired about on-campus hostel facility.
 - ➤ Singaporean Indian student has to perform 2 years National Service (NS) after 12th standard. Some parents are exploring the idea to give up Singaporean PR and send the student to India for college education.
 - Australia is one preferred route for higher education.
 - ➤ Parents found the Singapore College education costly, however the NU SEA/PIO quota tuition is affordable.
