



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS

Merit/Merit-cum means Scholarships

Every year the University extends financial support up to 100% of the tuition fee to meritorious students in the form of scholarship on the basis of merit and merit-cum-means studying in various institutes under the University based on the merit of admission.

Reimbursement of Interest on Student Loans

The University has a provision for reimbursement of interest on educational loan taken by a student from a nationalised or scheduled bank on merit-cum-means basis.

The student whose family income is Rs 3,00,000/- per annum is granted 100% reimbursement of interest of education loan and The student whose family income is Rs 5,00,000/- per annum is granted 50% reimbursement of interest of education loan.

Needy Students' Fund

The Needy Students' Fund is a special fund to provide scholarship and support to those students who experience certain untoward happenings in their lives or families, and are not availing any other scholarship. If any student has any tragic incident because of which he is unable to pay tuition fee, he can approach the University through the Head of the Institute and after due process, the said student can be given scholarship from the Needy Students' Fund.

Book Bank Facility

The University has a provision of Book Bank Facility to help the needy meritorious students. The Library Resource Centre provides book bank facility to the students of various institutes. The book bank facility is given to the 10% students of the total strength of each class based on the income of their parents and the upper ceiling of the same is Rs. 6 Lakh per annum.


Earn While You Learn

With an objective to give students hands-on experience, develop them for future jobs, and to encourage them for diversification of activities beyond the syllabus, 'Earn while you learn scheme' was introduced. The scheme was launched for meritorious and needy students enrolled with the Nirma University. The incumbent student is given work in the different areas including library (arrangement and display of books, issue and return of books, etc.), laboratory (equipment handling, maintenance, conduct of practical – only for postgraduate students), office administration especially Student Section (data handling, data preparation, filing work, drafting work), or they are engaged as teaching assistant (postgraduate students only).

Grievance Redressal Mechanism




An aggrieved student who has any grievances may lodge a complaint to the Institute level committee.

Equal Opportunity Cell




Mechanism for Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment


