








Academic Events -Battle of Wits

Fine Arts Event - Felicia







Theatre Event- Rangshala






Literary Events - LITWITS






Knock Out - A Debate Competition







GenOrator - The Speech Competition





The Fashion and Blogging Event- Enlivening



Sports Event- Take a Break: IPL Auction





Speaker Session - Dr. Chinmay Pandya











The Dance Event- Drop-A-Beat









The Music Event- Cadence









Guest Lecture on Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC)

CA Sunit Shah, FCA, IP, DISA (ICAI) and Managing Partner of SJSJ & Co., Chartered Accountant's Firm delivered the guest lecture on "Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC)" on February 11, 2021 in virtual mode on Cisco Webex coordinated by faculty coordinator **CS Jhanvi Betai**. Sir explained the applicability of the IBC code and its procedure in-depth. He briefed the participants on the various provisions of the said Code and explained how it is a time bound process to resolve the Insolvency process and emphasised the benefit it offers as a collective mechanism to lenders to deal with the overall distressed position of a corporate debtor. He then concluded his lecture by explaining the various professional opportunities available under the IBC Code. Around 45 students of Semester V joined the session.



"If we counted up the hours, we spend worrying about things that never happen, we'd probably find we've wasted half of our lives." - Susan Lewis, "No Turning Back"


National Level Case Study Analysis Competition 2.0 (NLCAC 2.0)






This was followed by prize distribution and recital of National Anthem.

You know you get this feeling often when you are alone.


