

INDUSTRIAL VISIT

Industrial Visit to Mundra Port

Seventy-five students from first-year B.Com (Hons.) visited Mundra Port during January 20-21, 2023 which was planned and coordinated by **Dr. Sumita Shroff Goyal** accompanied by four faculty members – **Dr. Avani Shah, Gopika Juneja, Vishal Kothari,** and **Dr Md. Mansur Alam.** The students visited Adani,



Adani Wilmar Plant, and Adani Power processing plants at Mundra. The students were briefed on handling container cargo, and the authorities shared the business model with the students. The students witnessed the manufacturing process of edible oils, including soybean, cottonseed, and groundnut, based in India India and selling under the Fortune, Raag, and Jubilee Brands.

Educational Visit to Gift City

Seventy-four students from the BFSI specialization accompanied by faculty - Dr. Hridaya Raj Bharti visited GIFT City in Gandhinagar, the only International Financial Service Centre (IFSC) in India on April 21, 2023. Mr. Sandip Shah and Mr. Shekhar Tejwani, coordinators from GIFT City, addressed the students and provided them with insights into the workings of various financial operations inside GIFT City, including the multi-service SEZ and exclusive International Financial Service Centre of the country. The visit was an enriching learning experience for the students as they were given a tour of the BSE - India International Exchange (India-INX) and other financial institutions such as LIC and SBI. During the visit, the students learned about online trading platforms and gained an understanding of the employment opportunities available in the financial sector. The visit was a valuable opportunity for the students to gain practical knowledge and see first hand the workings of the modern financial world. Overall, the visit to GIFT City was a great success, providing the students with a unique learning experience and an opportunity to apply theoretical knowledge in a practical setting.





NSS ACTIVITIES

Seven-Day NSS Camp



The NSS unit of the Institute of Commerce, Nirma University organized a seven day camp from December 30, 2022 to January 05, 2023 at Vasai - a village in Daskroi Taluka in the Ahmedabad District of Gujarat. Twenty-five NSS volunteers led by **Prof. Ashutosh Pandey**, NSS Programme Officer, conducted several activities like Yoga, No Tobacco Drive, Teaching Workshops in Government Primary Schools, Financial Literacy

and E-banking Awareness, Cleanliness & Plantation Drive, Nukkad Naatak, Folk Singing and Dancing, E-commerce Workshop for Women, Cultural Events and Sports for the Seven-Day Camp. In the no tobacco drive the volunteers organised a rally in the village and spread awareness through slogans "Ek-Be Ek-Be, Beedi Cigarette Chori De", "Jeevan Ko Bachana Hai. Tambaku Ko Hatana Hai". They spread awareness of the usage of e-banking and sensitized to UPI-related fraud. They whitewashed the walls of the school campus and planted trees. NSS volunteers also planned a drawing competition, card-making competitions and kite making competitions for the government school children. The cultural programme on January 04, 2023, provided a platform for the government primary school children to showcase their talent. The camp saw an active participation and great enthusiasm from villagers.



M.COM CURRICULUM REVIEW AND OFFICIAL LAUNCH OF ADMISSIONS



The institute organized a curriculum review of the Masters in Commerce with specialisation in Accounting and Taxation on March 18, 2023. The M.Com programme aims to empower future accounting professionals with advanced knowledge and taxation, skills in accounting, auditing. and digital transformation. Students will have the opportunity to work with leading accounting and taxation firms, which will provide them with valuable insights into the industry and help them develop their skills and knowledge. The USP of the programme is its alignment with US-CPA, ACCA, ICMAI (India), ICAI (India), and CMA (UK) courses which provides opportunities to the students

to pursue any of these programmes of their interest simultaneously. Experts from the industry and academia participated to discuss the M.Com curriculum considering the current trends and future prospects in the field of accounting and taxation. This was followed by official launch of M.Com (Accounting and Taxation) Admissions which aims to provide master's students with opportunities to gain practical experience through internships and industry projects. The seminar received representations of Principals, Heads of the Department, and senior faculty members from Sardar Patel University – Anand, Pandit Deendayal Energy University, Anand Commerce College – Anand, National College of Commerce, Umiya College of Arts and Commerce, Gujarat Commerce College, Prin MC Shah Commerce College, R.C. They further shared their suggestions on how this programme can help shape the future of accounting professionals.

ECONOMICS: AN EARLY NEED

It teaches vital concepts like poverty, GDP, and rural development. I advocate for schools to treat economics seriously and introduce it at the elementary level. Ultimately, economics permeates every field, and its inclusion in early education can foster a deeper understanding of various economic concepts.

In conclusion, while some may view economics as a small subject, its significance is undeniable. It touches every aspect of our lives, and I hope schools recognize its importance and incorporate economics into the curriculum from an early age.

CPR Training Session

Students practiced on mannequins under guidance, gaining

confidence and proficiency. The session was successful, providing valuable knowledge and skills emergency CPR. Regular practice is recommended to maintain proficiency, emphasizing the importance of everyone knowing this life-saving procedure.




