

SOCIAL INTERNSHIP @ ICNU

Internship is an integral part of the academic curricula at the Institute of Commerce, Nirma University. Satisfactory completion of summer internship is a mandatory requirement of the programme. Internship offers the students an opportunity to integrate the knowledge and skills acquired through the coursework; to gain hands-on organisational exposure; interact with professionals and other interns; and to improve their presentation, writing, and communication skills. Internship often acts as a gateway for final placement for many students. The general structure of the internship requires the students to undertake an immersive assignment within the assigned organisations for a duration of 4-6 weeks.

OBJECTIVE: The internship aims to achieve the following for the students:

- To make students sensitive to different social issues and enable them to become socially conscious and responsible citizens.
- An opportunity to develop the right work attitude, self-confidence, interpersonal skills, and ability to work as a team in a real organisational setting.
- An opportunity to further develop and enhance operational, customer service, and other lifelong knowledge and skills in a real-world work environment.
- Learnings as students apply their analytical, integrative, team skills in the work place.
- Networking opportunities with people from industry/organisations.
- Calibration of post-degree career plans based on real-life work exposure.

ELIGIBILITY

- The Institute of Commerce would facilitate internship opportunities to its students provided the student has successfully completed the previous semester examinations and their conduct at the University has been satisfactory throughout the programme.
- All the students enrolled in B.Com (Hons.) programme at the Institute of Commerce are considered to be registered with Institute for Summer Internship support, however students may look for opportunities on their own following the approval procedure.
- Students are required to have the desired attendance in their courses as per the prescribed guidelines to be able to participate in internship process.
