

## ABOUT US

Nirma University has an extensive library system, comprising a multidisciplinary collection of resources, equipped with state-of-the-art technology, which is now named the NIMA Knowledge Centre (NKC).

NKC comprises of Integrated Library Management System, seamlessly integrating library operations and services. The library comprises over 1,40,000 books and other library resources. About 80,000 e-books and 40-plus databases across different disciplines on the campus.

NKC has provided spaces for different needs like discussion rooms, digital labs, cubicles, light reading areas, training rooms, etc.

## AUTOMATION

NKC functions on an open-source library automation software KOHA, and RFID to manage its vast collection. KOHA has a web-enabled Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC), enabling users to inquire about resource availability while adhering to international standards such as MARC 21, Z39.50 encoding.

Registered library users have seamless access to digital resources both on-campus and remotely via RemoteXs. NKC have a dedicated page on the website <https://library.nirmauni.ac.in>, which gives access to all e-resources of our NKC.

## ***GUIDELINES FOR NKC USE***

- Silence should be maintained on the NKC premises.
- Students can borrow a maximum of 10 books for PG and 5 books for UG for the duration of 14 days.
- Books can be renewed only once if there is no reservation for it. Overdue books cannot be renewed.
- An overdue charge of Rs. 2/- per day, Reference Book - Rs. 100/- per day, Periodicals - Rs. 5/- per day will be charged on late return of NKC resources
- Books will be issued on producing the Identity card.
- The students should make an entry in the computer kept at the entrance.
- Books should be checked for missing pages or damage before issue. The students will be held responsible for any damage/missing pages found, and the penalty will be at the discretion of the librarian.
- NKC resources like reference books, periodicals, bound volumes, annual reports, CDs, and audio/video cassettes are to be referred to within NKC premises.
- Only one notebook is allowed to be brought into NKC.
- Issued books/Personal Books, files, spiral diary, spiral notes are not allowed to be brought into NKC.

## ***BOOK BANK FACILITY***

The Institute of Technology, the Institute of Law and the Institute of Pharmacy libraries provide the Book Bank facility to their students. The main aim of this service is to help the needy meritorious students.

## ***KIBO: LISTEN TO YOUR BOOK***
