


How a person's constitutional rights may be legally thwarted during police interrogation, however, has not been part of any meaningful discussion on police reform. 


Since 1995 there has been intense debate about whether the WTO Agreement is just. Nevertheless, justice in sovereign terms is different from justice in human terms. 
